The Summer Season commences on 21st/22nd October 2022.

Dear Players and Parents,

For inclusion into teams and to avoid disappointment, nominations (indicating your commitment) should be forwarded to the club to arrive by 19th August 2022.

Nomination forms may be printed and mailed to the PO Box 353, Daw Park, 5041; or filled out online and emailed to info@denmantennis.org.au. This season, you can also nominate through Club Spark via website <https://play.tennis.com.au/denmantennisclub/Membership/Join>

If you fill out the 'Intention to Play Form', **please ensure that you sign and date the back of the** and sign the front of the form. If you register through **Club Spark, all permissions are implied**. However you nominate, **your nomination means a SEASON commitment, so please do not nominate unless you are prepared to be available nearly every week**. If you are unsure whether you want to commit at this stage, please note this on the form, and you can decide after trials. We will need a commitment by 1st September to be included in a team.

Please ensure the email address on the form is one that is checked by an adult on a weekly basis. Most of the information during the season will be via email.

- ◆ Players who played Premier League Boys or Friday Night Girls last season will be contacted individually regarding trials.
- ◆ Orange Ball players are not required to trial.

Failure to attend trials may result in players not attaining the best position for their ability within the Club, even though every effort will be made to ensure correct selection.

This season, all players are required to have a Tennis Australia ID and a UTR profile. Instructions for this have been attached. It takes about 15 minutes to complete, and once it is done it will carry over for future seasons. There will be assistance at Denman on 11th September from 1pm to 4pm if you have problems creating these profiles

It is a rule of Southern Districts Tennis Association that all players have the right to choose which club they play for. It doesn't matter where you have coaching, or where you go to school, if you want to play for Denman, you are entitled and welcome to play here.

GOOD GRIEF - WHY ARE TRIALS SO EARLY?

- Once the children trial, we spend 1-2 weeks putting them in teams. They are due into the Association in early September
- 2nd week of September – Clubs are selected for Premier and Div 1 Teams by Association Permit Committee
- 3rd week of September – SDTA Junior Committee assigns the Clubs divisions based on nominations
- Final week of September – A draw is created and published by the end of the week
- 2nd week of October – Clubs deliver the alternate court roster
- Now we have all the information required to send it out to the players. The draw and alternate courts are added to our rosters, and the information sent.
- Hopefully, you will get the information during the week of 17th October 2021.

JUNIOR COMMITTEE

Below are the required positions for the club to run (relatively) smoothly. We are lucky in that we have had people volunteer for a few positions, and sincere thanks to those people.

However, we desperately need parents to volunteer to supervise Denman on a Saturday morning. We are also looking for a new Recording Officer and BBQ Manager.

Saturday Morning Denman Venue Supervisor – Time Requirement: 3½ hours every week when rostered on.

Duties: Arrive at Denman by 7:45am and remain there until 11:00am. Make sure Denman teams collect the correct folder & balls (if required). Make sure teams are playing on allocated courts listed on the board & ensure everything runs smoothly. This does involve knowledge of the rules, in order to resolve disputes. However, these are very rare and assistance on this is a phone call away!

This job can easily be shared among up to 4 people, and you will only be the venue supervisor when your child is rostered to play at Denman that day.

Recording Officer – Time Requirement: 2 hours every week.

Duties: Collect Results Sheets from Denman on Saturday afternoon. Record the results in SDTA Recorder and Denman Club spreadsheet. Training will be provided. This must be completed by 7pm Monday evening. This role would suit anyone 16 years or older. If older players have a school requirement of volunteer hours, this would be appropriate, and Anne will sign any forms to that affect.

BBQ Manager – Time Requirement: 1-2 hours each week.

Duties: Ensure the BBQ has enough food for each week. Purchase the goods when required, liaising with the club treasurer for reimbursement, and deliver the goods to Denman.
