TENNIS AUSTRALIA COMPETITIVE PLAYER PROFILES

All players are required by Tennis Australia to have a Competitive Player Profile (CPP). This is a 2 step process that requires a TA profile through Match Centre, and a UTR profile through a UTR site. If your child has already played a season, they already have a profile. It does mean that all children will require their own email. This needs to be set up by 1st September so that your child can be nominated in a team. If a profile is not set up by the nomination date, I will set one up for your child under a reasonably generic Denman email. That is not ideal though. If you need help setting up the CPP, please let me know and I will assist you.

Saturday Morning Denman Venue Supervisor – Time Requirement: 3½ hours every week when rostered on.

Duties: Arrive at Denman by 7:45am and remain there until 11:00am. Make sure Denman teams collect the correct folder & balls (if required). Make sure teams are playing on allocated courts listed on the board & ensure everything runs smoothly. This does involve knowledge of the rules, in order to resolve disputes. However, these are very rare and assistance on this is a phone call away!

Training for this position will be provided by Tennis SA for anyone who is interested.

This job can easily be shared among up to 4 people, and you will only be the venue supervisor when your child is rostered to play at Denman that day.
